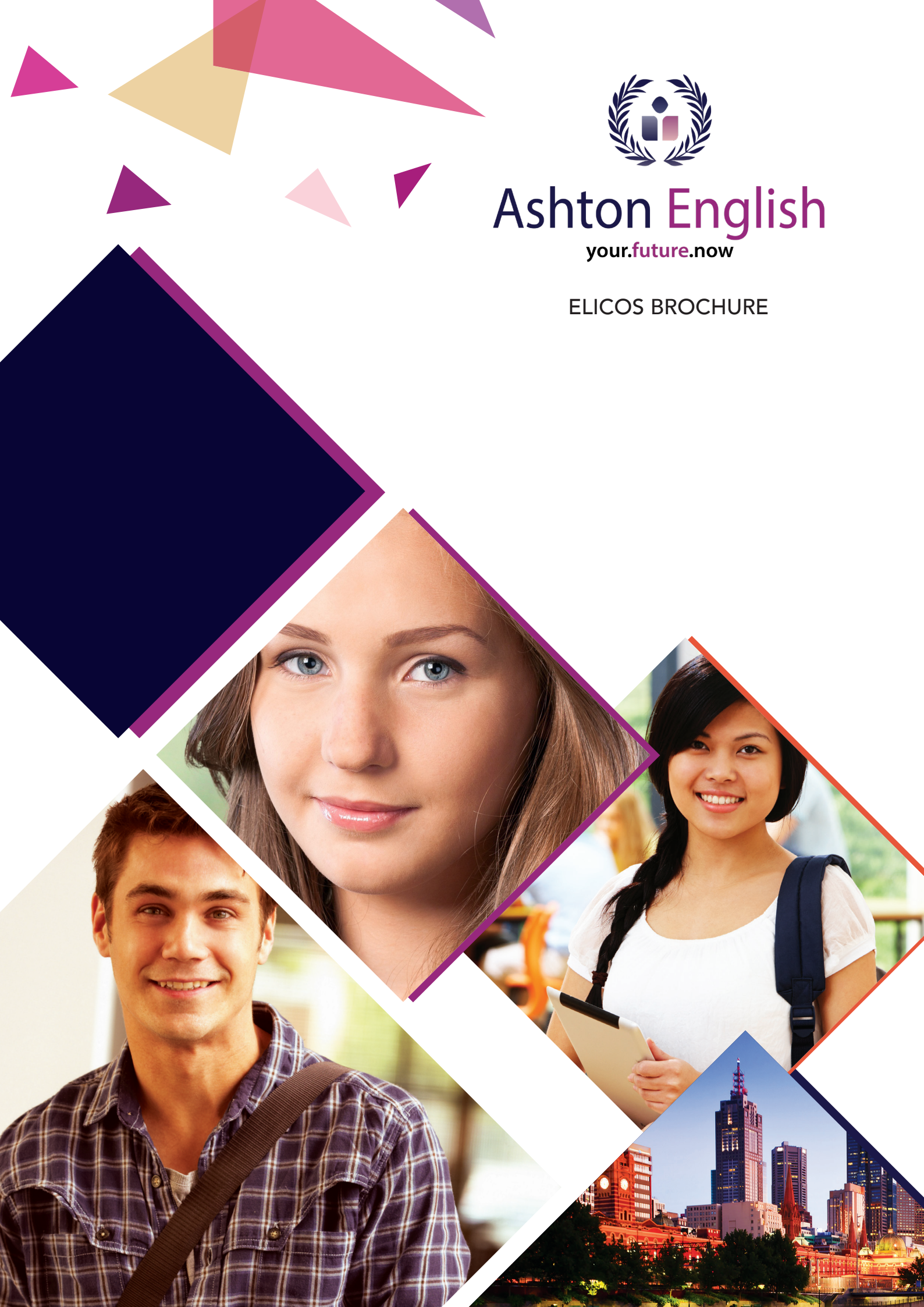

English for Academic Purposes /

CRICOS: 081503F

The English for Academic Purposes course is designed specifically for International students who intend to study in Australia, in the VET or Higher Education sector. The course aims to prepare students with the necessary research skills to succeed in further education and to familiarise them with the expectations placed upon them as tertiary level students in Australia.

Course aim

The course aims to orient students to the demands of studying in Australia, familiarizing them with: research, referencing and study methods, essay construction and writing types, academic listening and lecture note taking, discussion and tutorial participation skills, reading and critical thinking, completing projects and preparing and giving an oral presentation.

Entry requirements

Students must complete an entry level test before enrolling in the English for Academic Purposes course, be 18 years and above who have satisfactorily completed year 11 or equivalent.

Assessment Arrangements

These include written tests, essays, oral presentations, reading tests, listening tests, and observation checklists.

English for High School Preparation / CRICOS: 081502G

The English for High School Preparation course (EHSP) has been developed to meet the needs of students who seek the academic and English language skills necessary for study in Australian secondary schools. The course structure is based around the core subject of English as a Second Language and runs over a twelve week period. Additional to the core unit, there are: Literacy Focus on Maths and Read and Respond to Australian Texts.



Duration: 12 - 36 weeks

Course aim

The aims of EHSP are twofold; to develop the range of English language skills necessary for successful secondary school study and to introduce overseas students to the Australian secondary school system and the broader Australian cultural experience. Students can also expect to learn about Australian sports, local popular culture and to spend time becoming familiar with Melbourne.

Entry requirements

Overseas or non-English speaking students between the ages of 14 and 18 who have satisfactory language proficiency - IELTS overall score of 3.0 or equivalent.

Assessment Arrangements

These include written tests, essays, oral presentations, reading tests, listening tests, and observation checklists.

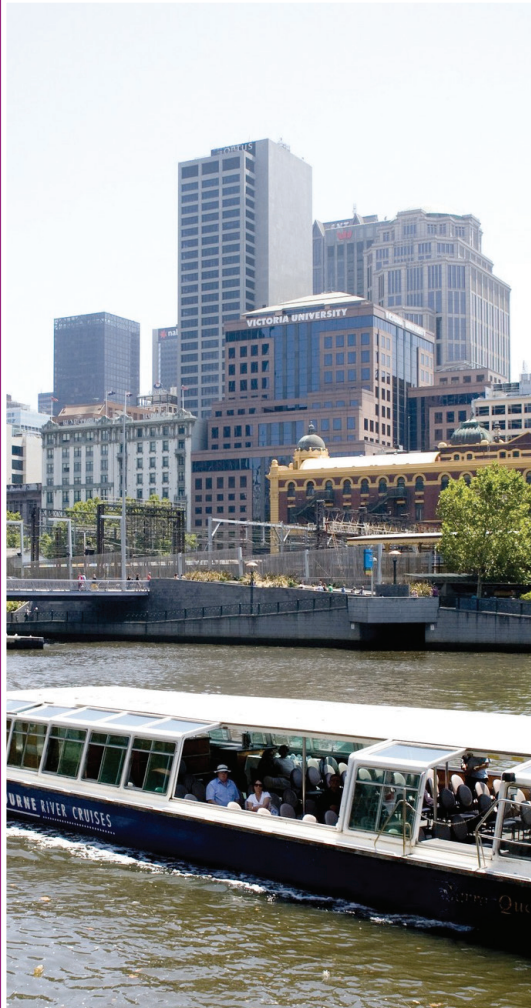

Orientation

An orientation program delivered to new students at Ashton English before course commencement involves familiarisation of living and studying in Melbourne and provides the opportunity for new classmates to interact and meet each other.

Medical and Health Cover

Ashton English can arrange Overseas Student Health Cover (OHSC) on student's behalf. In accordance with the conditions set out in student visas by the Department of Immigration and Border Protection, international students are required to have OHSC during their study period in Australia. OHSC can cover some of the medical costs incurred by students. Please indicate on your application form if you would like us to arrange it for you.

General Support

The Ashton English International Office located in Melbourne is a one-stop place for students and parents to request general information and assistance. Library Services

Ashton English will also assist you in applying for library cards from Melbourne City Library and State Library Victoria along with the local library near our campus in Footscray to borrow books and avail of their excellent study facilities.

Care and Safety

Ashton English is a friendly and secure place for students to study. Every student is valued as an individual and our staff are dedicated to meeting their academic needs and personal welfare requirements. Pathway to Secondary Schools

We are committed to assisting our students in smoothly transitioning into leading Australian public and private high schools on completion of the EHSP program. Through our close relationships with schools, agents and other educational organisations, Ashton English can support the placement of students in prestigious schools. Please contact the international office for further information.

Performance Supervision

Students are encouraged to use English throughout the entire day while at school. Academic and social activities will be supervised and a formal report will be sent to parents and/or guardians after each level. Parents and guardians are welcome to contact administration office for their child's most up to date progress report at any stage of the program.

Optional Service for EHSP Students /

Ashton English provides the following optional service to EHSP students, listed below. The items have been collated to support a stress free stay transition to Melbourne. Please note this service incurs additional charges which must be paid at the time of letter of offer.

SIM Card Preparation

Pre-paid SIM cards will be registered and activated for students before their arrival in Melbourne. International Office staff will offer one-to-one support to help students learn how to top up their phone credit and how to use plans within Australia. (A SIM Card Fee and an AUD\$30 voucher have been included.)

Student Myki Card Preparation

A Myki Card is a re-usable, credit card sized smartcard that stores value which is used as payment for public transport fares around Melbourne and surrounding suburbs.

A student Myki Card with 4 weeks fare will be prepared for students. International Office staff will offer one-to-one guide to teach students how to use public transportation systems in Melbourne.

Bank Account Open Assistance

International Office staff will go to the bank with students to help them open an Australian bank account.

Secondary School Enrolment Assistant

International Office staff will contact the secondary school where students intend to enrol, and help them complete necessary documents required.

Campus Visit and Interview Transfer

International Office staff will take students to visit the secondary school campuses before completing their EHSP in Ashton English and attend interviews (if required) up to 2 times.

Homestay re-arrangement and transfer

After completing the EHSP program in Ashton English, students will usually change to another homestay family close to the secondary school. International Office staff will arrange new homestay families, if required, and help students transition over to their new accommodation by introducing them to the new family. Transport of belongings to the new location is the responsibility of the student.

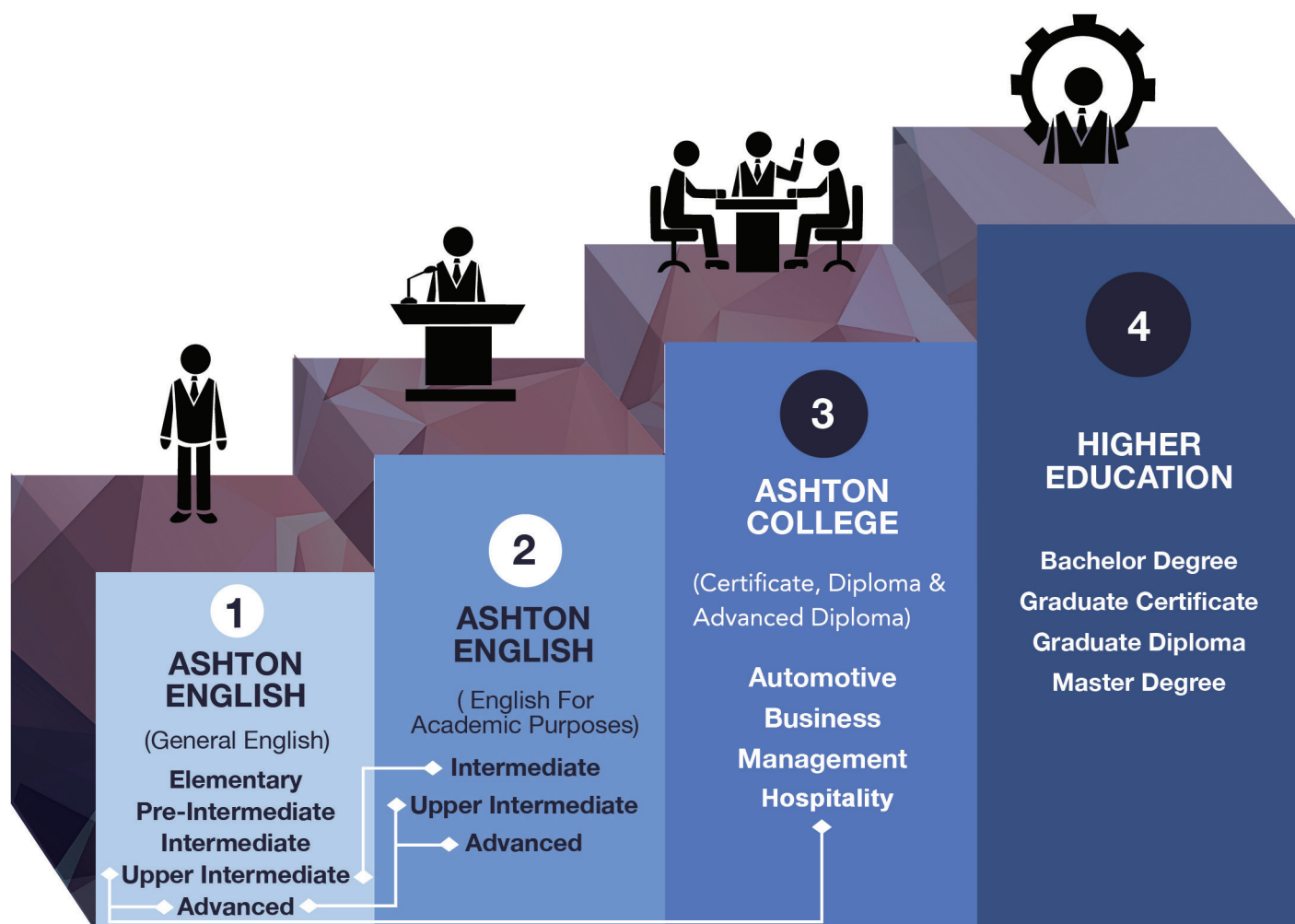

Here are some of the costs associated with living in Australia. According to the Department of Immigration and Border Protection, you will need a minimum of \$19,830 (excluding tuition fee) to cover health services, accommodation, food, transport, books, clothing, entertainment and other expenses.

- Enrolment fee of \$250 is non-refundable.
- Overseas Student Health Cover (OHSC) provided by Bupa is the preferred Overseas Student Health Cover provider of Ashton English. Single Policy cover for student only. A student is defined as the primary student visa holder. Couples Policy cover for the student and their partner as listed on the student's dependant visa. Family's policy covers for the student, their partner and their dependent children under 18 years of age if they live with the student in Australia. Family policy covers for the student, their partner and their dependent children under 18 years of age if they live with the student in Australia. Fees mentioned above are approximate. - Homestay fees must be paid for 4 weeks in advance. The bond deposit of 4 weeks is also required. The bond is refundable at the end of Homestay arrangement provided there is no money owing for unpaid rent, bills or damage and appropriate notice is given (two weeks) in written.
- Students who are under 18 years on a Confirmation of Appropriate Accommodation and Welfare (CAAW) issued by Ashton College will be required to use the Ashton English airport pickup service.
- Guardian fee – Ashton College can provide long and short term guardianship for students. Our fees have been structured to allow us to provide quality care at the lowest possible cost.
- EHSP students (optional services) is not a mandatory service. If parents do require these optional services they need to pay this fees at the time of letter of offer. Once these fees are paid, it not refundable.
- All fees (except enrolment fees \$ 250) are refundable in case if student visa is rejected. Refund will be made within 28 days of receiving the rejection letter.
